### **Lasell Village Director of Wellness Earns National Leadership Award**

NEWTON, MA -- Lasell Village, an award-winning continuing care retirement community at Lasell College, is pleased to announce that Robin Scully, RN, Director of Wellness at Lasell Village, recently received the 11th Annual Joan Anne McHugh Award for Leadership in Long-Term Services and Supports Nursing presented by LeadingAge at its Annual Meeting in Indianapolis, IN.

The annual award recognizes aspiring nurse leaders who provide excellent clinical care to their residents while demonstrating a commitment to the field of LTSS nursing.

The unanimous choice of the Award Selection Committee, Scully was described in her nomination as an “exemplary hands-on RN with an ability to juggle management and clinical care duties.” Scully began her career at Lasell Village 16 years ago.

“She instills confidence and loyalty in all who work with her,” said Lasell Village President Anne Doyle, who noted that almost all of the Certified Nursing Assistants Scully has recruited over the last decade still work at the Village.
