



Visitor Guidelines for Lasell Village and Lasell Studios Effective 6/08/2020

Lasell Village invites family or friend visits between 10:00 AM and 4:00 PM daily. Residents or visitors should email Will at the Welcome desk (wcarter@lasell.edu) or call (617-663-7000) to give the names of expected visitors. These visits must take place outside; under no circumstances should visitors enter a resident's apartment. If needed, Lasell Village will limit the numbers of visitors on campus at any one time.

Visitors, please help us to keep your loved one safe and healthy by adhering to the following guidelines while you are on the Lasell Village campus.

1. Each household is limited to two (2) visitors at a time; feel free to bring leashed pets. Park in Lot A or Lot B (closest to the Grove Street entrance).
2. You will need to sign in and complete the Welcome Desk screening at each visit. The staff checking you in will take your temperature prior to contact with your loved one. If your temp is 100 degrees or higher, you will be asked to leave and reschedule your visit.
The screening questions are: have you had any close contact with a person diagnosed with Coronavirus? Have you had a recent loss of taste or smell? Do you have a fever greater than 100? Have you had a cough or sneeze or sore throat that is not allergy related, or experienced shortness of breath or headache in the past 14 days?
3. Thoroughly clean your hands with hand sanitizer when you enter the Welcome Desk area, prior to meeting with your loved one, and when you leave the Campus.
4. Wear a mask at all times while on campus making sure that it covers your mouth and nose. Everyone, residents and visitors, needs to wear a mask. No eating or drinking during the visit.
5. Ensure that you keep 6 feet apart from residents, and ensure no physical contact at any time. Specific table and chair combinations across the Village campus have been marked with tape to aid you in keeping a safe distance.
6. Feel free to walk on the fire road; it is the only path wide enough to maintain the six-foot distance.
7. If you need to use a bathroom while you are here, only the bathroom closest to the Welcome Desk at 130D Seminary Avenue may be used.
8. You should notify the Welcome desk at 617-663-7000 when you leave campus.
